It will allow field staff to remotely update investigation data, view project status reports and receive priority jobs as they are logged, this significantly enhances data security with multifactor authentication and achieves immediate work flow efficiencies.

Adding CLEW's interactive capabilities to the Polonious IMS application will enable major cost savings for investigation teams by interactively allocating jobs using the technology. Furthermore, by integrating Alacrity's CLEW in to its investigation management application, Polonius is enhancing its ability to track case progress as it happens, via CLEW technology.
