Alacrity Technologies has appointed a former electoral commissioner as a non-executive director.

Andy Becker spent eight years at the Australian Electoral Commission as electoral commissioner and deputy commissioner, and 16 years as the South Australian electoral commissioner.

He managed the 2001 and 2004 federal elections and oversaw the Constitutional Convention election and the 1999 referendum. During his watch, the AEC was involved in capacity building operations, election observation and providing expert assistance to more than 20 developing democracies, earning a reputation for being at the forefront of electoral technology and management.

Alacrity makes an interactive mobile internet platform called CLEW (Closed Loop Environment for Wireless). It is designed to give organisations the power to interact with mass audiences through mobile phones and the internet.
